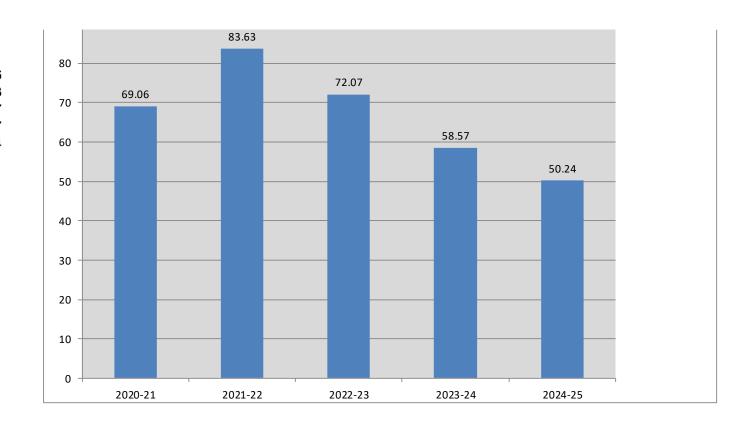

ENROLLMENT – 5 YR. HISTORY

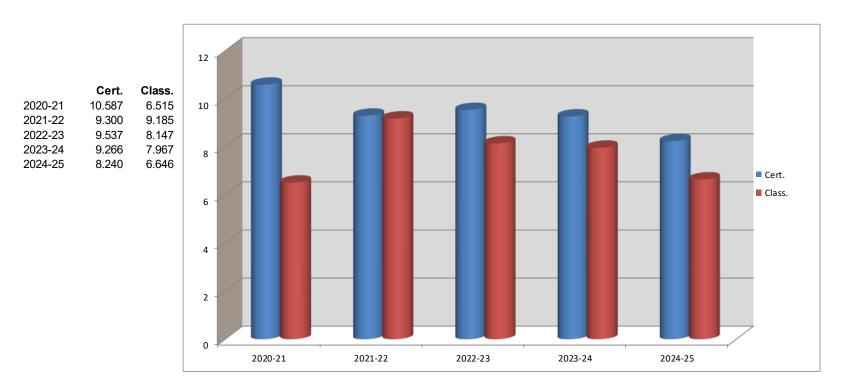

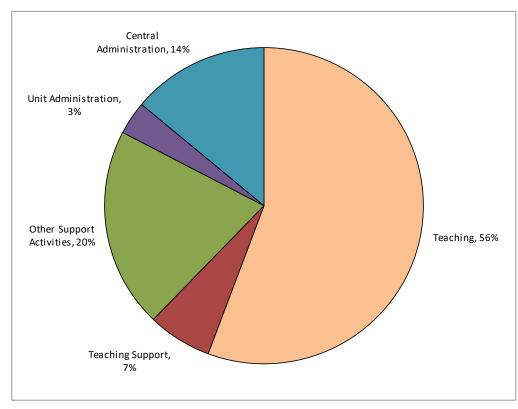

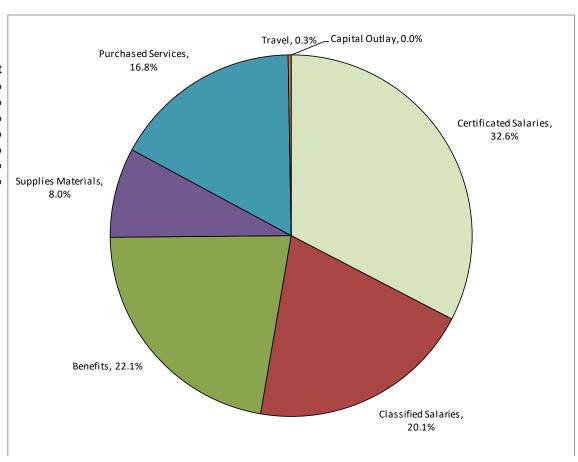
