

Student Demonstrations and Strikes

The Board is the local entity responsible for elementary and secondary education. Education leadership rests with the Board, its administrators, the school superintendent, and teachers.

The Board recognizes the right of students to dissent so long as the day-to-day educational process is not disrupted or hampered.

When such dissent includes violation of the rights of other students to an education, or when such dissent involves force, threat of force, or actual law violation, those responsible will be subject to relevant discipline procedures in the Student Handbook.
