**BOARD POLICY**

NO. 3110

**MANDATORY ATTENDANCE**

All parents, guardians or persons residing in this School District having custody of any child 8 years of age and under 15 years of age shall cause such child to attend the schools of this District if the child resides for the full time when the District schools are in session unless the child attends a private school for the same time or unless the Superintendent shall excuse such child from attendance because attending a residential school operated by the Division of Institutions, Department of Social and Health Services.

Any child 15 years of age and under 18 years of age shall be subject to the same attendance requirements unless such child has already attained a reasonable proficiency in the branches required by law to be taught in the first nine grades of the public schools of this state or the child is regularly and lawfully engaged in a useful or remunerative occupation, or the child has already met graduation requirements in accordance with the State Board of Education rules and regulations, or the child has received a certificate of educational competence under rules and regulations established by the State Board of Education under RCW 28A.04.135.
