DRESS AND GROOMING

Student dress and grooming is the responsibility of the individual and his parents under the following guidelines:

1. Dress shall be clean and in keeping with health and safety practices.
2. When a student is participating in a special activity, he/she must dress, groom and conduct him/herself according to the standards and training rules established by the coach or special activity director.
3. As a matter of safety and health, shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals are acceptable footwear (not thongs) but are worn at the risk of the individual.

These rules as stated are to encourage students to dress cleanly, attractively and neatly. This type of dress will facilitate a good classroom atmosphere and encourage pride in the school and fellow students.

Teachers may establish more stringent and definite guidelines on hair and clothing to meet the safety standards of their unique classroom situation if necessary.
