Transportation to and from School

The Board believes that it is in the best interest of the district to offer a program of free student transportation to students in the district enrolled in the public school. Transportation routes shall be established in a manner which safely and efficiently serves eligible students and which meets the needs of special students.

In the event that the Board, because of road or other conditions, determines that transportation will not be provided, parents/guardians of students who reside in the district may submit a detailed monthly request for reimbursement for transportation costs to the school or nearest bus stop. Distance is measured from the resident property boundary nearest to the school or bus stop. Reimbursement is subject to Board approval.

The Superintendent is authorized and directed pursuant to applicable law and WAC regulation, to implement the district's transportation program.
