ILLNESS DURING SCHOOL

Minor accidents will be taken care of in the office. In case a student is ill, his parents or guardians will be contacted by telephone as soon as possible and the student may lie down in the sick room until the parents arrive. A school authority may take the student home, or to the hospital or doctor's office if the seriousness of the illness indicates such action. If it is not possible to contact any parent, the Superintendent's decision will be final.

All students leaving the school must check out with the Superintendent's/Secretary's office. Students 18 years of age or older may sign out for themselves. All other students must have the signature of a parent or guardian (or designated individual) signed in the office at the time they are taken from the school premises.
