### **STUDENT CONDUCT**

#### **Closed Campus**

The school campus is closed to all students during the regular school day. This applies upon arrival at school in the morning, during the morning refreshment break, at lunch time and the noon break and until the student leaves the school by private transportation or the public transit. Students with a need to leave the campus during this time must have written permission from the school office.

#### **Forged Notes**

Notes giving permission or otherwise transmitting information must be Signed by the parent or guardian. Unless parents or guardians have made Prior arrangement with the office, other signatures are not acceptable.

#### **Students over 18**

Students over eighteen who are living at home will be subject to the same rules and parental permission as others.

#### **Leaving School**

Parental permission is required for students to leave the campus during the school day. In the absence of written permission, the school will contact the parent prior to the student leaving. Sick children whose parents cannot be reached will remain at school.

#### **Telephone Usage**

Student phone calls shall be arranged with office personnel.

#### **Parking**

Student vehicles will be parked on the parking strip adjacent to the school. Once a student arrives at school automobiles are off limits. Students may not sit in cars during lunch.

Detention

The teacher assigning detention shall make contact with the parent/guardian regarding the infraction. This contact should be in person, by phone if possible. In case a parental contact can't be made, a written explanation shall be sent to the home. In the event that bus transportation is involved, detention shall be assigned for one day later in order for transportation to be arranged.

Tobacco

The use of all tobacco products is forbidden on school property.

Textbooks

Textbooks are furnished by the school district. The students are responsible for the care of the books loaned to them. The students will be required to pay for damage to the books beyond that of reasonable wear, if such damage resulted from improper use of the book or improper care.

Visitors

All visitors are to report to the office upon arrival. Parents and/or Guardians are welcome and encouraged to visit the school at any time.

Insurance

Student insurance will be made available. The cost is determined each year. All students who play inter-scholastic sports are required to have either student insurance or be included on a family policy. Evidence of coverage is required.

Alcohol, Chemical Substances and Tobacco Products

*A student shall not knowingly possess, use, transmit, be under the influence of, or show evidence of having used any alcoholic beverage, illegal chemical substance or opiate, or tobacco product.*
