BOARD POLICY

NO. 3140

NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

Students who wish to attend the North River Schools from residences outside the district must first secure release from their resident district.

Parents or guardians of prospective students who do not reside in the North River School District must also complete the Application for Admission and submit it to the Superintendent along with the proper release from the district of residence.

Parents or guardians who reside in a non-high district are required to complete only the Application for Admission for secondary students.

The Superintendent is authorized to allow temporary admission pending formal Board action. If, in the judgment of the Superintendent, there are reasons of a serious nature for consideration of disapproval of the Application for Admission, no action will be taken until formal consideration by the Board of Directors.

In the event an Application for Admission is rejected, parents or guardians may wish to pursue the statutory appeal process.

Non-resident students must have completed all enrollment requirements by September 1 or the start of the school year. Special conditions may exist for which acceptance may be considered for the start of the second semester of the school year.
